SAFETY TIPS FOR CAMPUS PARKING LOTS

If you feel unsafe while on campus, the best thing to do is to contact Campus Safety. Campus Safety works with our local police department to ensure our community remains safe. If you see something, say something! If you witness suspicious activity, remain calm and call the police or Campus Safety to provide critical information. Describe specifically what you observed, including:

- · Who or what you saw
- When you saw it
- Where it occurred
- Why it is suspicious
- Brief description (clothing color, male/female, hair color, etc.)

Did you know that NOCCCD has Stryker Evacuation Chairs? These chairs can evacuate anyone from our 10-story building in the event of an emergency, including those who are injured or disabled. These Stryker chairs are located in Stairwell #2 (toward the front/west of the building) from the 3rd through the 10th floor.

SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY REPORTING

Remain safe on campus and always be aware of your surroundings while leaving/returning to your vehicle in the parking lot. Stay alert for suspicious activity and remember Campus Safety is here to assist you. Here are some helpful tips from Campus Safety to ensure a secure campus:

- Walk confidently and briskly. Remain alert and avoid looking at your phone.
- Scan the area surrounding your car. If you see someone around your vehicle and feel unsafe, use the buddy system or ask Campus Safety to escort you.
- If a suspicious person approaches, change directions and go to a place where there are people or call Campus Safety.
- Practice preventative safety measures like carrying a whistle, carrying your keys in hand, and knowing where our <u>code blue telephone posts</u> are in the parking lot.
- Make sure you lock your doors and hide your belongings when you leave your car.
